Exhibition *Conditions of Entry*

All entrants must be members of the Hand Weavers & Spinners Guild NSW Inc or a member of one of the Guild's network groups.

Items must have been completed within the 18 months prior to the exhibition (i.e. after 1 January 2016).

Please attach a sample of the fibre/s or yarn/s used.

State end use of entry if hand spun yarn or handwoven or felted fabric.

If the item is for sale, a fibre content and care label is required to be attached. Include this with your entry not attached to it.

Do not label your entry with your name &/or address.

Wall hangings must be ready to hang. You may include a sample of yarn, fibre or fabric to be hung with your work for visitors to touch.

All entries will be considered for the appropriate award/s and there are no specific requirements except for the "miniature" category. Consider the awards when designing your entry as some entries (e.g. a handwoven silk scarf could be considered for the weaving, the silk and the colour award.

Entries must be received by May 1, 2017.

Please pack entries carefully in suitable material, preferably not see-through. Packaging will be re-used to return your entries.

Receipt of your entries will be acknowledged by email, or please send a stamped self-addressed envelope.

Entries may be left at the Guild rooms on Thursday 27 April or Saturday 29 April if they are not posted.

Multiple entries may be posted together. An **Entry form needs to be attached to each entry.**

While in transit and throughout the exhibition, insurance is the responsibility of the entrant.

All work will be subject to selection and the selectors' decision is final. Not all entries may be exhibited, depending on space and selection criteria.
